She only uses these unique beads...Lovely and impressive although he didn't have a very big inventory as those beads are scarce.

We visited a custom shoe "factory", little shop where the designers were crafting a shoe that resembled a real foot, and one for a tiny baby. Unique shoes of flesh leather, so one would think you were really barefooted when you wear these shoes. Amusing.

We visited a small "jumble shop" with bakalite necklaces and earrings from the 20's, antique costume jewelry and very unusual finds. Tempting.

We were advised to eat at Osteria Enoteca San Marco...a local place with good views.
